



## Taeda – BR - A Grade (1st Quality)

Species: pinus taeda - taeda pine - from Brazil  
Sizes: 11-50mm thickness  
72-140mm width  
900-2440mm length (1830mm with dog ears if for fencing)

Other sizes available on request

Tolerances: typically thickness +1mm/-0mm widths/length +2mm/-1mm  
Mostly no undersize

Finish sawn

Moisture: KD target 8% -12% (Max 14%)

Wane: Mostly without wane

Pith: unlimited

Stain: Mostly without stain

Mould/Fungus: Not permitted

Log source: Typically a majority cut through the core (Inner sections of the log)

Face: Boards are graded from the best face

All other naturally occurring defects not compromising the structure of the material allowable.

Typical applications: Pallets & Fencing (Packaging, Boxes, Crates, Dunnage)

Note: As timber is a natural resource some variation is typical, it is however expected that a minimum of 95% of each pack will be within the tolerances specified herewith.
