



Taeda – BR - B Grade (2nd Quality)

Species: pinus taeda - taeda pine - from Brazil
Sizes: 11/15mm thickness
100/140mm width
1800mm length (1830mm with dog ears if from fencing)

As B Grade is A grade pallet and fencing fall down other sizes will be available depending on what A Grade (1st Quality) material is produced

Tolerances: typically: thickness +1mm/-1mm widths/length +2mm/-2mm

Finish sawn

Moisture: KD target 8% -12% (Max 14%)

Wane: Some wane permitted.

Pith: unlimited

Stain: Blue stain permitted

Mould/Fungus: Some dried mould/fungus permitted

Log source: Typically a majority cut through the core (Inner sections of the log)

Face: Boards are graded from the best face

All other naturally occurring defects not compromising the structure of the material allowable.

Typical applications: Pallets, Packaging, Boxes, Creates, Dunnage, Fencing

Note: As timber is a natural resource some variation is typical, it is however expected that a minimum of 95% of each pack will be within the tolerances specified herewith.
